

2012 INNKEEPERS RACE RULES AND GUIDELINES

All teams must consist of 4-6 racers, including at least one female. No more than 6 racers may be active or registered to race on any given week, no "alternate" racers will be allowed; 6 racers in total, any week, on any team.

All members must be over 18 to participate.

Scoring will be by actual time – taking the best 4 times of your team for that week. Points are awarded for place in each division

Teams need to field 4 racers in any given week to count for team standings.

If you have an injured member you may pick a permanent substitute for the remainder of the season. Your team may also pick a permanent substitute for the remainder of the season should another team member become unavailable to race for your team for some other reason. Please do not abuse the substitution rules at the end of the season by asking to insert competitors who may be construed by other teams as "Ringers". Any substitutions made after Week 8 will be made at the sole discretion of the Innkeepers Race Committee. Any injured or otherwise incapacitated team member may rejoin their team at any time during the season; both the substitute and original member results will count towards team standings, but individual standings will only count if 8 out of 10 races are completed.

If a member of your team cannot race one week – you may **NOT** have a temporary substitute that will count for results. If you field a temporary substitute, the time for that competitor will not count for that week, and unless your team fields the minimum of four registered teammates, your team results will not qualify for that week. The results will only count should that temporary substitute become a permanent team member for the rest of the season.

You need to complete your run between 10:00 A.M. – 12:30 P.M.

This year's race courses will be primarily on Wardance, with some weeks on Chief and Bull Run.

If you do not have a seasons pass you may purchase a discounted lift ticket at the administration office for that day only. Discounted tickets are \$20.

Some other stuff:

To place in your division, you must make 8 out of the 10 races of the season. The same goes for team scoring.

If you race all 10 races, only your best 8 times will determine where you place.

And, very important: Your starting division may be on an interim basis. Individual overall times will be looked at after your 4th race, and if there is a need to move you into another division, it will happen at that time. This means if you don't complete your 4th race until the 6th week, you may still be moved. This, hopefully, will discourage sand-bagging!

Points are awarded to every finisher for each race in all divisions. Those individuals who have the most points at the end of the season will win their respective divisions, and team standings are based on total team points accrued each week from the four best finishes from your team members. There is also an award for the fastest overall team. These two divisions are the Cruickshank Division and the Kollar Division respectively.
